REDLANDS—One fling has been quietly gaining interest over the course of a year, and the Boys & Girls Club of Redlands is hoping to expose more families to it through an upcoming tournament.

Disc golf, often referred to as “Frisbee golf,” is a relaxing game that anyone can participate in. No experience is necessary, and no one is too old or too young to learn how to play.

On Saturday, June 21, the Boys & Girls Club will host “Spring into Summer Fling” at Ford Park, beginning at 9:30 a.m. The first tournament held last summer drew nearly 30 participants.

“Frisbee golf is a family-oriented sport,” according to 10-year-old Samuel Maury-Holmes, who won first place in his age bracket at last year’s tournament at Ford Park. “It’s an easy game to learn for anyone who’s never played before.”

Samuel’s brother Joel, 8, won first place in the 7-year-old division in 2007. Both brothers, along with their father Bill, competed in the San Marcos Ice Bowl disc golf tournament in February.

Registration begins at 8:30 a.m., with a clinic to be conducted by advanced amateur player Bill Maury-Holmes at 9 a.m., and competition for kids ages 7-12 will begin at 9:30 a.m., followed by competition for children and adults ages 13 and older starting at 3 p.m.

Registration is free for children 12 and under; registration for all others is \$15. All participants receive a disc to keep and compete with.

The tournament will be held at Ford Park, where teams of up to four players will compete on a nine-hole, par 3 course, constructed by the Inland Empire Disc Golf Association and tournament co-sponsor Redlands Morning Kiwanis.

Competition is limited to the first 90 players who register; prizes will be awarded in the various age brackets, underwritten by Mikan Restaurant, the Boys & Girls Club of Redlands and Redlands Morning Kiwanis.

Players will participate in two rounds, including a consolation round.
